

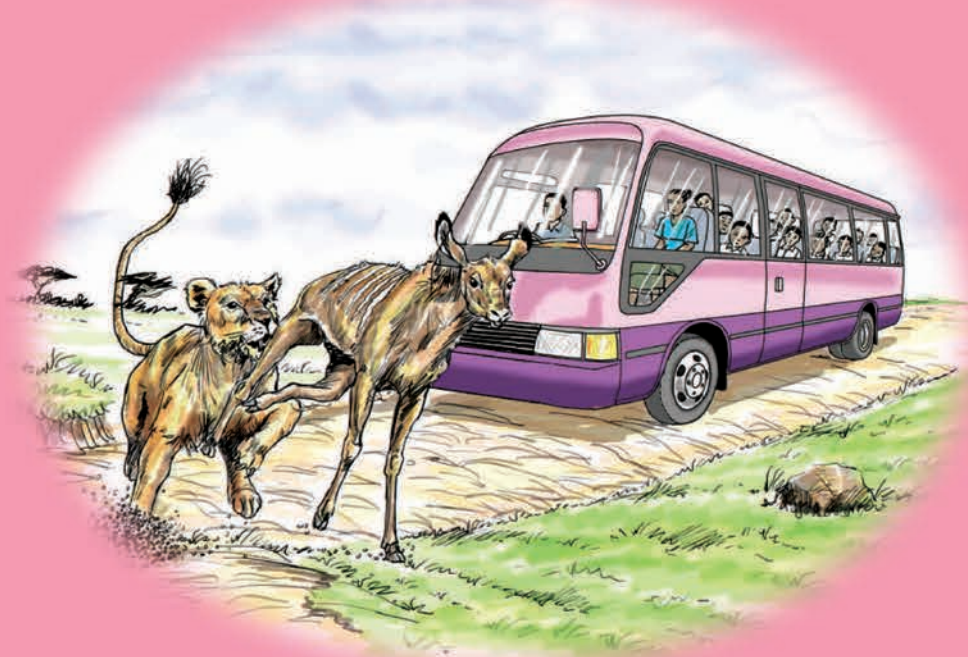

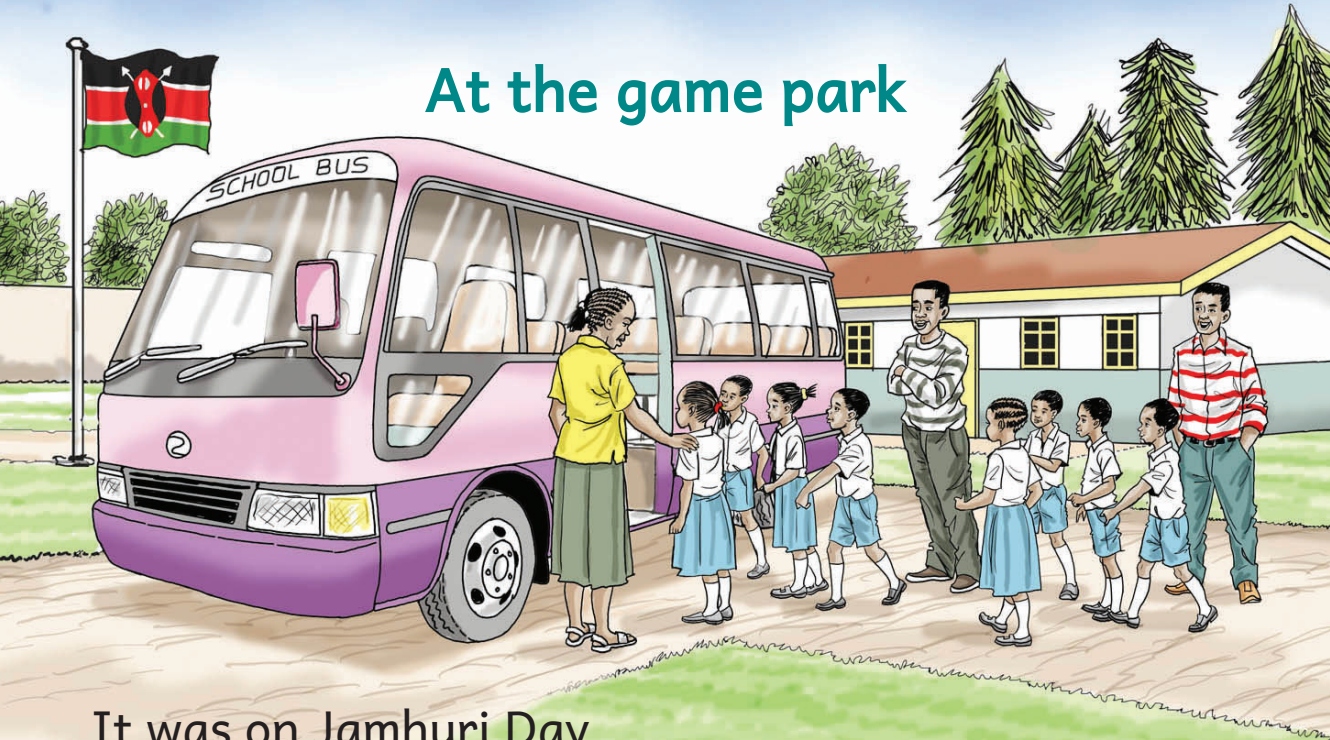

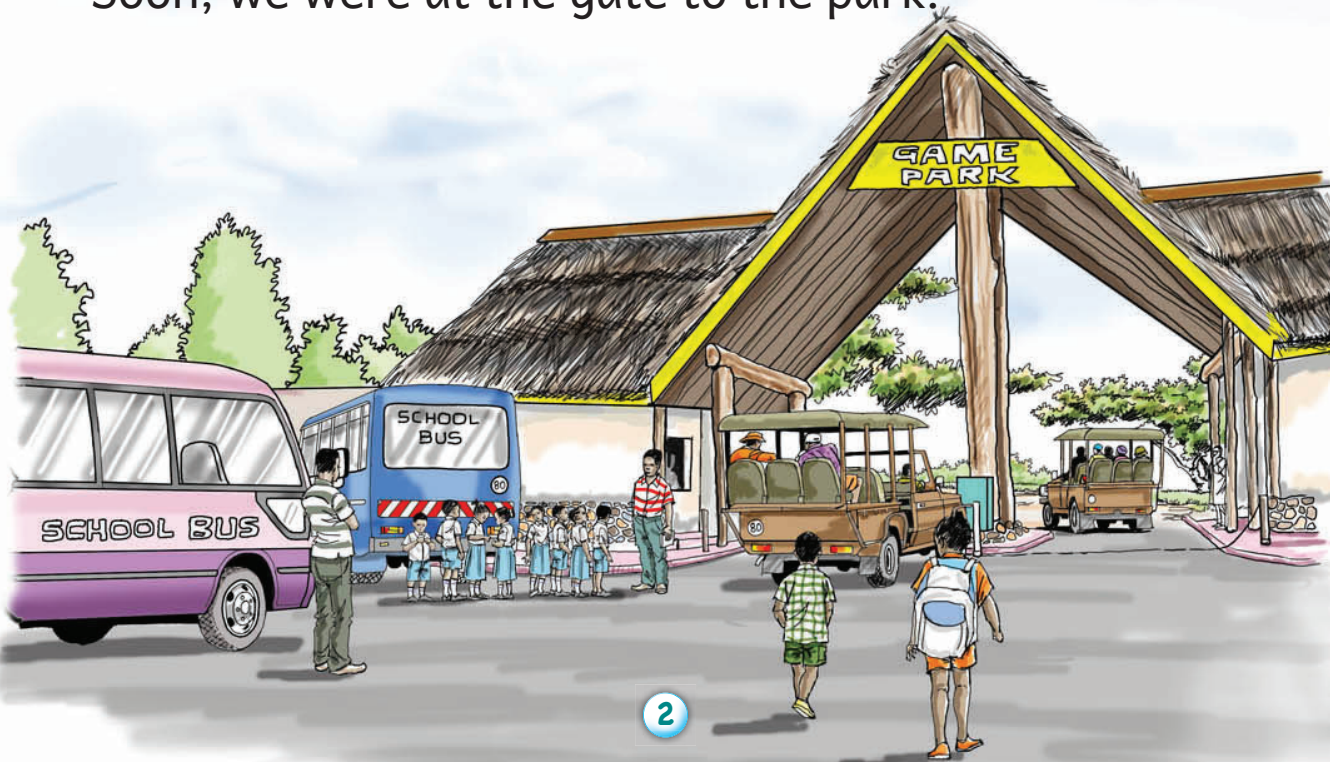

Soon, we were at the gate to the park.





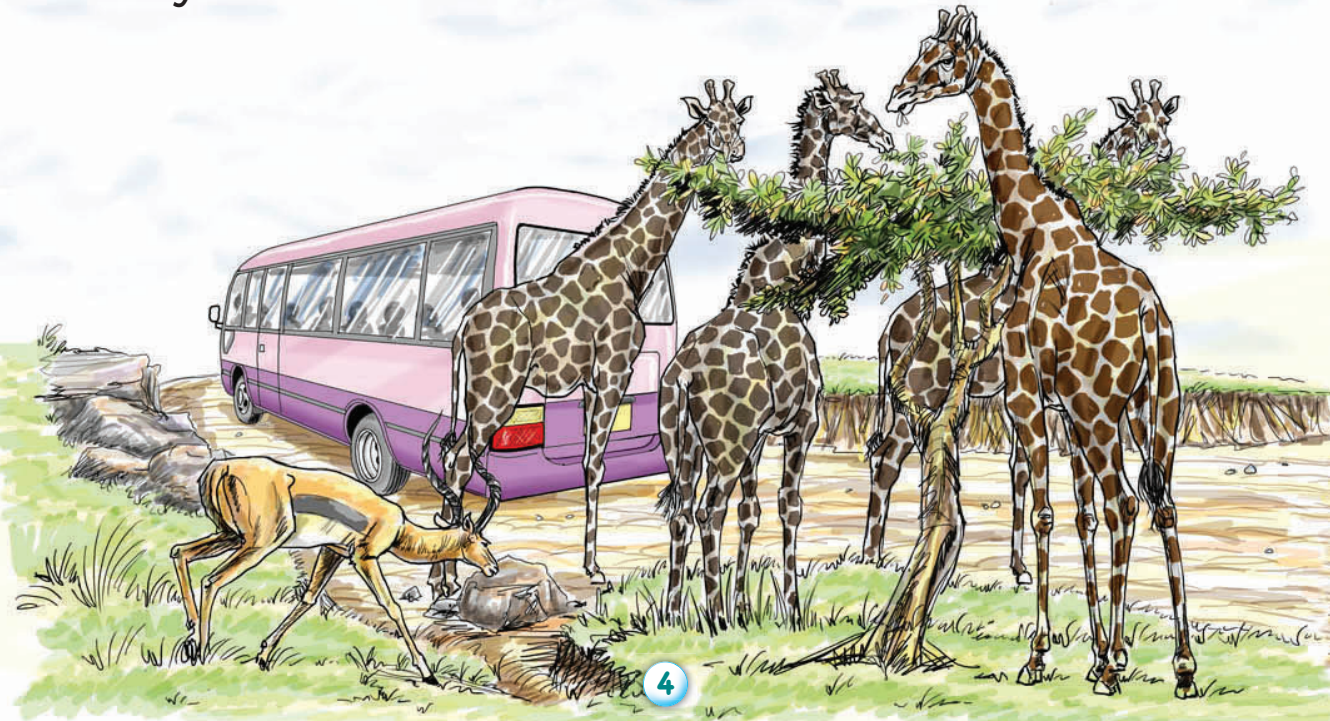
In the park, the bus moved slowly.

There were zebras, antelopes and an elephant.



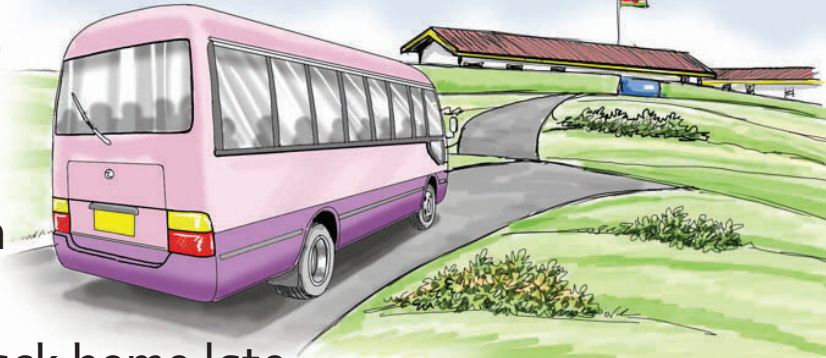
After eating lunch, we went to see more animals.
