Or

b) Drama

David Mulwa, Inheritance.

Drawing illustrations from Mulwa's *Inheritance*, write a composition on what Causes misery in leadership in Africa are those who are close to ruler.

Or

c) Novel

John Steinbeck, The Pearl

With close reference to Steinbeck's The Pearl, write an essay on how superstition may sometimes affect the way people live their lives.
