

She planned to sleep till Saturday.


Soon, Nana was deep asleep.

The farms were green.


The aeroplane landed at the airport.

Nana took good care of her crops on the farm.






Nana had chickens on her farm too.

Nana was now a tailor.






She mended torn clothes.


She also made new dresses.

She went to look for food.


Nana walked around the house.
