Trees are important in our life. A large area covered with trees is called a forest. There are two types of forests. These are natural forests and planted forests. Natural forests grow on their own while planted forests consist of trees planted by man. Most of the natural forests are found in areas which receive heavy rainfall.

An area covered with trees looks very **beautiful**. Trees make the environment look pleasing. Trees also prevent soil from being carried away. This is called soil erosion. An area without trees has very hard ground because the top soil has been carried away by wind or water.

Trees are also homes for animals. Animals like monkeys and cheetah live on trees, Birds also make their nests on trees. Trees give us food. We get fruits from trees. We also get timber for making furniture from trees. Carpenters cut down the trees into wood. Cupboards, beds, chairs, tables and also papers are products from trees.

Some doctors also treat us using medicine which is gotten from trees. These medicines are called herbal medicines which treat many deadly diseases.

We should take care of trees. Warn those people who cut down trees and encourage them to plant as many trees as possible. Have you planted trees in your home compound?
