 - (c) Give **six** lessons Christians learn from the incident in which Jesus forgave the sinful woman. (6 marks)

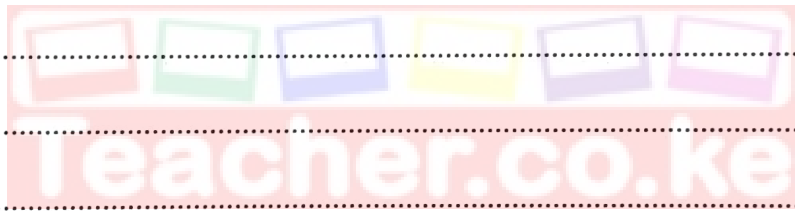
