INSTRUCTIONS TO THE SUPERVISOR

The supervisor is expected to:

- (i) ensure the test is administered within the time allocated i.e. 30 minutes for planning session and 1 hour and 15 minutes for the practical session;
- (ii) ensure each candidate has the question paper and writing material for the test;
- (iii) ensure that the candidate is **not** given assistance either during the planning session or at the time of performing the practical test. The candidate is however, allowed to use reference materials such as recipe books, exercise books and any recipes, during the planning session. Note that previously written plans are not allowed.
- (iv) collect all the question papers, original and duplicates of recipes, order of work, order list for foodstuff and equipment at the end of the planning session;
- (v) give the duplicate order list for foodstuff and equipment to the Home Science teacher to facilitate the compilation of requirements for shopping;
- (vi) seal the rest of the test in an envelope and hand them over to the head teacher for safe keeping;

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These instructions consist of 2 printed pages.

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- ensure the practical session starts on the first day as indicated on the KCSE (vii) timetable. If this does not happen, he/she should write a report;
- (viii) allow ample time between the sessions for change over during the practical;
- collect the sealed envelope containing the test from the head teacher on the day of (**ix**) the practical test. Issue the question papers, the original copies of the recipes, order of work, list of foodstuff and equipment to the candidates and hand over the copies of the same to the Home Science teacher to facilitate marking;
- collect the marking schemes from the Home Science teacher after every practical **(X)** session and staple them together with each candidate's script, seal the envelope and hand it over to the head teacher to return to the distribution centre;
- receive the assessment report form for the centre, the manual marksheet in a sealed (xi) return envelope and all the candidates' scripts in another sealed return envelope at the end of the examination for onward transmission to KNEC.



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
