- Clamp
- Boss
- Stand
- Optical pin (one)
- Copper wire (15 cm long)
- Protractor
- Two pieces of plasticine
- Cork

QUESTION 2

- One dry cell and a cell holder
- A voltmeter
- An ammeter
- A wire mounted on a mm scale labelled K
- seven connecting wires with at least four with crocodile clips
- A micrometer screw gauge (to be shared)



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
